

Smithwick Family of Rogues 1969-1992

The Rogue first appears on the 1969 color chart. I will give my best guess as to the date each model number was introduced. All the Rogues look so much alike. The exceptions are the Lipless Rogue & Spoon Bills. I have pictures for most of them. Some of the earlier ones I only had the color chart picture and it was too small to reproduce.

The base model and the Rattlin' Rogue use the same blank. They just add the rattle.

When the SB-1200 came out in 1970 it had the standard Rogue plastic lip. At some point in the future it was redesigned with a metal diving lip.
